EO APAC is hosting a fireside chat with Dr Jennifer Doudna in the last week of February/March 2021 (subject to confirmation). Dr Jennifer is a biochemist and Professor at the University of California, Berkeley and who codiscovered the CRISPR gene editing tool that has been receiving a lot of publicity and has been constantly referred to by Singularity University speakers.

For this work, Dr Jennifer (together with Dr Emmanuelle Charpentier) was awarded the 2020 Nobel Prize in Chemistry . In this fireside chat we will be diving into DR Jennifer's journey as a woman in STEM, as well as the moral and ethical issues of this discovery, its patent and potentials both good and bad.


